

Treasure Hunt Rules

The goal is to visit each business on your map to receive a stamp and a special treat. All completed treasure maps will be entered in a drawing to win the treasure chest of goodies!

1. Treasure hunting will take place Oct. 7-21, 2022.
2. Maps must be stamped by each participating stop on the map in order to be a qualified entry.
3. All completed entries must be dropped off at the borough office at 175 Orange St. by Oct. 21 at 5:00.
4. Each child must be accompanied by an adult when visiting participating stops.
5. Only ask participating stops for a stamp and treat.
6. If a stop would close or change their hours, a missing stamp will be overlooked. The entry will be considered eligible.
7. One entry per child.
8. Participation is limited to children in K - 5th grades.
9. Costumes are not required, but are welcome!
10. The drawing for the treasure chest will be held at the Fall Festival on Oct. 22 at 5:45pm at the 2nd St. Community Center.
11. Copies of the map are available at the borough office, participating stops, www.17857.org, and on 17857.org's Facebook page.
12. Winner does not need to be present to win.

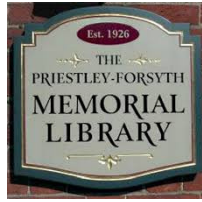
